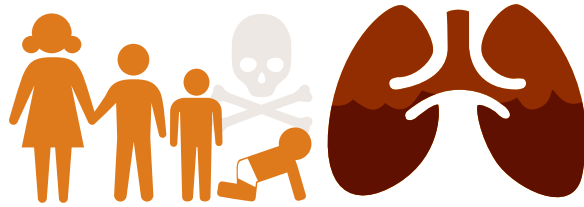
CHILDREN IN LOW-INCOME COUNTRIES

BREASTFEEDING PRACTICES

PROGRESS THROUGH ADVOCACY

Increased political commitment and expanded funding have contributed to the following progress in global health:

- » The **prevention of over 6 million child deaths** (a two-thirds drop in deaths) thanks to malaria control efforts since 2000
- » A **nearly 60% reduction in new HIV infections** among children between 2000 and 2014, thanks to better prevention of mother-to-child transmission
- » An **increase from 20% to 83% global coverage of children receiving tetanus vaccinations** between 1980 and 2014
